

ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

Programmes Affiliated to Bengaluru North University

Postgraduate Programmes

M.Sc. in Counselling Psychology:

The M.Sc. Counselling Psychology programme seeks to develop competent and integrated counsellors who value diversity and personal growth, who can provide services across a continuum of developmental stages for individuals and interrelated systems, who are able to collaborate with allied mental health services. The course focuses on the student's personal and professional development by enhancing their theoretical understanding, increasing their awareness to become a 'reflective practitioner,' deepening their personal insight and developing counselling skills.

M.Sc. in Psychology:

M.Sc. programme in Psychology aims at helping and equipping students with both conceptual inputs and hands-on skills training to identify and respond effectively to the needs of individuals and social systems in the world today. This programme lays the foundation for further research in psychology. The overall philosophy of the M.Sc. Psychology programme is to prepare master's level students with academic, professional, and personal credentials to perform effectively in their anticipated work setting.

VALUE ADDED / CERTIFICATE COURSES

The add-on course fosters staff and student excellence. It encourages the students to go beyond the textbook, the classroom, and the curriculum. Challenging them to think out of the box, form their own opinions, and keep them updated with current developments in the field. It also teaches them skills needed as a professional.

Certificate Course in Counselling Psychology (CPCP):

CPCP is a 6 months certificate Course. This course is a practical and stimulating course for those in the field of helping and caring professions which offer guidance and support. The course teaches the accurate application of counselling skills through classroom teaching as well as practical guidance. Moreover, the participants also will be trained in actual counselling through practical requirements. Along with providing a solid foundation in counselling skills and application of the same to various populations like children, adolescents, youth and the aged, this course also incorporates the application of Life Skills.

Diploma Course in Psychodrama:

The course focused on training the participants on how they can do one to one therapy using psychodrama techniques on online medium DCP has been proven to promote creativity and social skills and empathy. DCP is action based and enhances human interaction. This is how Psychodrama consolidates and extends its own counsellors' role.

Certificate programme in Art Based Therapy:

Art therapy is a type of psychotherapy that utilizes art and artistic mediums to help people explore their thoughts and emotions in a unique way. The idea behind this type of therapy is to use art as a primary means of communication, something that can be useful for those who find it difficult to verbalize their feelings. Being practical and using physical objects, such as paintbrushes and paper, people are helped to feel more connected to the world around them, standards of practice in the art therapy field.

Admission Process and Student Strength

The admission process for the year 2023-24 included an entrance test and interview for PG the applicants and only an interview for UG applicants. Montfort College follows a roster system. The admission process started in the month of May and 184 applications were received for Postgraduate courses and 85 applications for Undergraduate courses under the Management quota. 60 PG students and 35 UG students were selected after the proper procedure from the management's end. 25 PG students joined through University Admissions.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The college building has a built-up area of 39,926 sq. ft on four floors; our hostel building has a built-up area of 21,540 sq. ft also on four floors. We have a separate cafeteria catering to the food and snack requirements of the students and faculty. The college has three functioning bore wells which ensure uninterrupted water supply to us. We also have a rainwater harvesting system in place, which re-charges the bore wells. Solar heating systems are installed on the terraces of both the college building and hostel building to meet our hot water requirements. A 30 KVA Diesel Generator set ensures an uninterrupted power supply to college and hostel buildings. In addition, we have a large parking area, garden, and sports area.

The courses adopt an ICT-enabled teaching-learning process. Faculty make use of teaching aids like models, charts, animations, games, puzzles, etc. Classrooms and labs are furnished with blackboards and whiteboards along with LCD display—assisted projection and audio-video systems. Group therapy rooms are carpeted from wall to wall and provided with curtains and other requirements to provide proper acoustics as well as a one-way mirror for training and supervision. There are 16 classrooms on campus and 8 and 12 restrooms for men and women respectively. The college uses internet services provided by

ACT Enterprise. The campus is safe and secure with 26 CCTV cameras and 24X7 security present on campus. The campus is completely walled and has solar lighting.

Library

The library is an integral component of the institution ever since its inception in 1998. The library offers vital support for teaching, learning, and research activities of the College by disseminating knowledge and offering modern services to the academic fraternity. The college library is well equipped with close to 9000 textbooks, e-books, and research articles from e-journals, encyclopaedias, journals, and a variety of reading material. In addition, the college also subscribes to an online reading library. The library is normally open all weekdays from 8.30 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. except Sundays and government holidays.

Computer Lab

The college computer lab has systems for student use with internet and printing facilities. The lab is normally open all weekdays from 8.30 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. except on Government holidays. The college has Wi-Fi internet access for all students.

Psychology Lab

The college has multiple well-equipped Psychology labs to enable the students in learning and research. The psychology lab is an area where students can learn the use of various tests and assessments to be effective Psychologists. Specially designed assessment rooms provide students with the opportunity to conduct assessments in a standardized and conducive atmosphere.

Media & Journalism Lab

A designated Media & Journalism lab has been instituted on the college premises with active 24/7 news live-streaming available to the students. The lab also has newspaper editing software installed to be used for the creation of InDesign pages and newsletters as part of the professional development of the students. The lab boasts effective music systems, radio equipment and cameras to prepare students for a broadcast career in the future.





Case conferences

As part of their course work, third and fourth-semester PG students present the cases of the clients they see during practicum. These cases include the client's case history, mental status examination, diagnosis, case conceptualization and treatment plans. At these conferences, participants are encouraged to have active discussions in order to further their learnings.

In the year 2023-24, **20** such case conferences were conducted, with a total of **40** students presenting cases to their peers. The sessions were well-received by the students and showcased their professional skills to formulate and plan treatment for various clinical/counselling cases.
